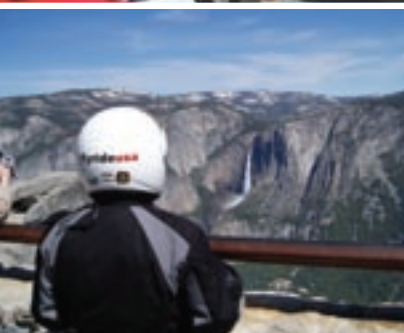

Questions & Answers

How do I book a FLYRIDE-USA tour?

Complete and return a Booking Form. You can also book online or by telephone and/or e-mail.

What's included?

Motorcycle rental, basic liability insurance, essential touring accessories/equipment, experienced professional tour guide(s), pre-booked accommodation, tour orientation, detailed maps, tour information pack, AAA/CAA membership, airport transfers, tour caps, first/last breakfasts, 24hr on-the-road tour support.

What does motorcycle rental include?

Bikes are equipped (where applicable) with windshield, tank bag, hard/soft panniers, luggage rack, tail pack/top box, passenger backrest, Scottoiler®, manufacturer's owners manual, comprehensive tool kit and puncture repair kit.

What's not included?

Flights, fuel, food, CDW, NTS (see below).

Where do we fly to?

FLYRIDE-USA's local airport is Redmond/Bend (RDM). Our fly-in customers generally travel via San Francisco (SFO), Seattle (SEA) or Portland (PDX). The short flights from these airports to Redmond/Bend fly over the Cascade Mountains, part of the Pacific Ring of Fire. Get a window seat!

What about airport transfers?

All airport transfers are included in the tour price. Please note that it is the customer's responsibility to forward relevant flight information to transfers@rdmshuttle.com.

Do we start riding on day of arrival?

Most people arrive on a Saturday (or earlier), we start riding on Sunday.

Do the tours require group riding?

Tour members can ride with the guide or choose their own riding companions, routing and schedule. Your guide will be contactable (signal permitting) by cellular telephone for any assistance you may need on tour.

Do we ride every day?

FLYRIDE-USA Guided Tours have built-in rest/contingency days. We often stay two/three nights in the same location to provide relaxation, sightseeing and/or the opportunity to explore.

What gear should we bring?

We recommend comfortable (on and off the motorcycle), protective, lightweight, breathable, weatherproof, layered clothing; lightweight, breathable, weatherproof boots; unscratched/new tinted and clear visors; two (summer and winter) pairs of gloves and good quality sunglasses (that work with your helmet).

What level of experience is required?

Riders are required to have two years fully-licenced riding experience on 600cc+ motorcycles (or 250cc+ scooters for scooter riders).

What documentation is required?

Rider will need a motorcycle operator's licence and a credit card. Non-US citizens will require passports. All documents must be current/valid.

What kind of accommodation can we expect?

We use carefully selected lodging, usually with swimming pools, hot tubs and in-house laundry facilities. We also work with high-quality properties within the boundaries of National Parks. Rooms are generally en-suite.

What will the weather be like?

The weather in the Western States/Provinces is generally sunny, dry and warm from mid May through late October. Temperatures can vary widely with elevation.

What about empty luggage?

For your convenience, empty luggage can be left in storage with FLYRIDE-USA for the duration of your tour.

Are there optional excursions?

Grand Canyon flights, Monument Valley 4X4 tours, Columbia Icefield tours, Yosemite hiking, Hoover Dam 'Hard Hat' tours, Rogue River jet boat tours, Rocky Mountain 4X4 tours, Columbia River sternwheeler cruises/dinners, jet skiing, North America's steepest mountain gondola, dinner trains, whale watching, horse riding, festivals, natural hot springs, beaches, spas, historic hotels, National Park lodges...

Are there any rules?

If you cannot make it to your pre-booked accommodation by 19:00hrs please advise your guide.

What is the Vehicle Security Deposit?

The VSD is a reversible authorization-only credit/debit card transaction for US\$1,500. It is recommended that all riders confirm the availability of these funds on their credit/debit card account before travelling.

What is Collision Damage Waiver Insurance?

In case of 'at-fault' damage/loss, CDW will conditionally limit rider financial liability to US\$1,500. When CDW is declined, rider 'at-fault' damage/loss financial responsibility may be rated to the replacement value of the motorcycle and/or accessories.

What is New Tyre Supplement?

NTS guarantees brand new tyres fitted to your bike from day-1 of your ride. This is the way to avoid mid-tour tyre changes (and possible inconvenience).

Can I extend my holiday?

You are welcome to arrange extra motorcycle rental days and additional pre-booked hotels to suit your needs.

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Guided Tours can be reserved only with the payment of a non-refundable deposit. The balance is due 180 days before the date of motorcycle pick up. If the balance remains unpaid after the due date shown on the Rental/Tour Agreement, FLYRIDE-USA reserves the right to cancel the booking. If the deposit is paid by credit/debit card, the balance will be automatically charged to the same card on the balance due date unless an alternative method of payment is requested. Payments cannot be reversed or refunded for late motorcycle pick ups, mid-term cancellations or early motorcycle returns. All cardholders must be present at motorcycle pick up.

Motorcycles are delivered to/collected from the Phoenix Inn Suites, 300 NW Franklin Ave, Bend, Oregon 97701 unless otherwise agreed. Rider will need to present a current/valid motorcycle operator's licence and any relevant credit/debit cards at the time of motorcycle pick up. Additional riders must hold their own (separate) Rental/Tour Agreements.

To offset availability issues, motorcycles are reserved on a 3-model preference basis. Due to delivery delays, manufacturer recalls, warranty claims, insurance claims, late returns, non-returns, malfunctions, punctures, tyre failures, injury/illness, extreme weather, accidents and other circumstances beyond our control, FLYRIDE-USA cannot guarantee brand/model availability.
